

In Jesus'/Yeshua's name, as a believer & a member of the "Body of Christ", I, _____ decree that:

1. According to Jesus/Yeshua, not believing in Him is a sin. **I WILL** believe in my heart & confess with my mouth that Lord Jesus Christ/Yeshua is the Son of God/Yahweh & that God/Yahweh raised Him from the dead. **I WILL** confess with my mouth that Jesus Christ/Yeshua is Lord to the glory of God the Father. Anyone who believes in Him or call upon the name of the Lord will be saved. I am saved. **I WILL** ask Jesus/Yeshua to come into my heart to be my Lord & Savior & also to be baptize me with the gift of the Holy Ghost and with fire. The Holy Ghost is the Spirit of Truth.
2. **I WILL** submit myself to God/Yahweh & surrender everything to Him. **I WILL** seek first the Kingdom of God, & His righteousness, & in all these things shall be added to me & **I WILL** repent for the Kingdom of Heaven is at hand.
3. Jesus/Yeshua is the Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world. It is written, "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord. By grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God. Not by works, so that no one can boast" (Ephesians 2:8-9). Even though all of our sins are forgiven, I want to remove the barrier to fellowship that my sins have put between Jesus Christ/Yeshua and me so that I can be free to enjoy full fellowship with Him and to do His will. Galatians 5:19-22, John 16:9, James 4:17, 1 Corinthians 6:9-10, & Revelation 21:8 are sin-related scriptures. **I WILL** confess of my sins and ask for forgiveness so that He will remember my sins no more. **I WILL** repent of my sins and turn away from my sins. **I WILL** turn towards Jesus/Yeshua by faith. It is written, "Confess your faults one to another, & pray one for another, that ye may be healed" (James 5:16). **I WILL** be cleansed with the blood of Jesus Christ/Yeshua from all sin (1 John 1:7 & 9). **I WILL** ask the Holy Ghost to help me to defeat the temptation of every sin until I have complete victory over them.
4. **I WILL** forgive others for their trespasses committed against me. It is written, "For if ye forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you: but if ye forgive not men their trespasses; neither will your Father forgive your trespasses" (Matthew 6:14-15). If I have difficulty forgiving someone, **I WILL** be moved by faith & say what Jesus/Yeshua said, "Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do." **I WILL** also forgive myself. **I WILL** pray to be cleansed with the blood of Jesus Christ/Yeshua to remove the sins of unforgiveness, hatred, bitterness, or shame.
5. **I WILL** help to enforce Satan's defeat because I have been given the power over every spirit of sin, iniquity, death, infirmity, sickness, poverty & injustice. Jesus/Yeshua said, "Behold, I give unto you the power to trample on serpents & scorpions and to overcome all the power of the enemy; and nothing shall by any means hurt you". **I WILL** not rejoice that the spirits submit to me, but **I WILL** rather rejoice that my name is written in heaven (Luke 10:19-20).
6. **I WILL** develop a personal relationship with God by praying, meditating on the Word of God daily & obeying it. Prayer is the secret to a personal relationship with God. **I WILL** pray the Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13) ***Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come. Thy will be done in earth, as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. For thine is the kingdom, and the power, and the glory, forever. Amen;*** and/or The Jabez Prayer (1 Chronicles 4:10) ***Oh, that You would bless me indeed, and enlarge my territory, that Your hand would be with me, and that You would keep me from evil, that I may not cause pain;*** and/or the bless the people with The Aaronic Blessing/The Priestly Blessing (Numbers 6:24-26), which can be prayed using the divine names of God; ***The LORD/Yahweh/Adonai bless thee, and keep thee; the LORD/Yahweh/Adonai make his face shine upon thee, and be gracious unto thee; the LORD/Yahweh/Adonai lift up his countenance upon thee, and give thee peace.***
I WILL pray without ceasing. **I WILL** include worship & praise during my prayer time with God because God is worthy. **I WILL** pray for the peace in Jerusalem (Psalm 122:6-9). **I WILL** act as an intercessor for my family, friends, nation's leaders, church/synagogue leaders, other believers, children, unbelievers, enemies & other nations. **I WILL** put on the whole armor of God to stand against the wiles of the devil (Ephesians 6:10-17). Some mountains are more difficult as stated in Matthew 17:21, "but this kind does not go out except by prayer and fasting." Fasting means going without food to spend time in prayer. **I WILL** humble myself by prayer and fasting. It is written, "So we fasted and besought our God for this: and he was intreated of us" (Ezra 8:23). Daniel faithfully continued praying and fasting for 21 days while waiting for an answer from God. God's messenger arrived 21 days later stating from the first day his words were heard by God, but the prince of the kingdom of Persia had detained him and Michael, one of the chief princes came to help him (Daniel 9 & 10). Satan may intervene in delaying my response from God, but **I WILL** have faith & no doubt until He answers. It is written, "...whatsoever you shall ask in prayer, believing, you shall receive."
7. Death & life are in the power of the tongue (Proverbs 18:21). Jesus/Yeshua states that what we say reveals what is in our hearts. **I WILL** ask the Holy Ghost to transform my mind and heart with new attitudes & motives so that **I WILL** speak life and blessings and not death or curses. Jesus/Yeshua states, "Have faith in God. If you have faith and doubt

not, you can say to the mountain, move from here to here & it will move. Nothing will be impossible to you. Everything is possible for him who believes.” Faith comes by hearing & hearing the Word of God. **I WILL** call those things that be not, as though they were. **I WILL** cast out devils in the name of Jesus/Yeshua as stated in Mark 16:17.

8. **I WILL** use my abilities, spiritual gifts, and/or anointing to fulfill Jesus’/Yeshua’s Great Commission as stated in Mark 16:15-18, “*And he said unto them, Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; they shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover.*”; and as stated in Matthew 28:18-20: “*And Jesus came and spake unto them, saying, All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth. Go ye therefore, and teach all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost: teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you: and, lo, I am with you always, even unto the end of the world. Amen*”
9. **I WILL** be a cheerful giver in tithes & offerings. Offerings are gifts brought to God beyond the tithes. God blesses those who give freely of their possessions, time, & energy. **I WILL** give in proportion to what God has given me by giving freely & generously. **I WILL** honor the Lord with my possessions & with the first fruits of my increase.
10. **I WILL** have genuine compassion for the poor, widow, helpless, orphans & the oppressed. **I WILL** be “fearless & bold as a lion” to fight against injustices of the poor, widow, helpless, orphans, & the oppressed.
11. It is written, “The Lord our God is one Lord: and thou shall love the Lord thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might. And these words, which I command thee this day, shall be in thine heart”: and **I WILL** teach them diligently to my children when I sit at home, when I walk down the road, when I lie down & when I get up (Deuteronomy 6:4-7). **I WILL** train a child in the way, he/she should go, & when he/she is old, he/she will not depart from it (Proverbs 22:6). **I WILL** bless the child/children using The Aaronic Blessing (Numbers 6:24-26).
12. **I WILL** obey the Word of God by applying it to every aspect of my life & especially through every trial & tribulation because “all scripture is God-breathed & is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting & training in righteousness, so that the man of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.” There are blessings for obedience.
