

WHAT ARE DEVILS?

Devils blind unbelievers from hearing the gospel and bind them up from getting saved, deceiving them all the way into hell. Devils also deceive a person to not get delivered from their power.

Devils can bind up a person's spiritual growth. That person may not want to study the King James Bible, pray or participate in church leadership or evangelise. The person may object constantly and feel uncomfortable with preaching inspired by the Holy Spirit. That person often may not be getting anywhere spiritually and wonders why. That person may constantly fall back into sin after deciding to repent.

A person gets possessed with a devil through the following doorways - constantly breaking the ten commandments, love of possessions, exposure to book or film about witchcraft or magic, performing rituals, or having a witchcraft spell cast on the person at any time in life or even before birth. Devil possession is becoming rampant now in children through toys, through the word, *magic*, whenever it is used. Playing with these toys allows the child to become depressed with unclean spirits of sadness and fear. Possession also comes when someone casts a spell on a pendant worn around the neck, or bracelet or ornament or jewellery, which is then given to another person to keep. This will let that person who keeps it become possessed. Worldly music and television and advertisements allow a person to come under the possession of an unclean spirit. In all cases you will know that a person has been possessed if that person shows the symptoms of slow spiritual progress as described above.

Devils gain access to a person through cursed objects which that person may have and use, such as a modern bible and many other things which you can even find in modern churches. Modern bibles are cursed because they are based on manuscripts found in Egypt and not on the original manuscript of the Holy Bible. Then the devil visits that person and vexes that person with impure thoughts or dreams. By having this access, the devil can and does bring all sorts of problems in that person's life while awake.

Devils can inhabit a person. A person can be tormented or vexed by devils inside the person, through pain, voices, evil thoughts or an evil presence or through dreams and visions of horrible things. Also without taking possession of the person, a devil can actually oppress through chronic life

problems and lack of progress. A devil can possess a person causing strong feelings of anger, disappointment and sadness, illness, physical deformity or even death. Once a devil has gained possession of a person, it will not leave unless it is cast out through deliverance.

Sometimes a devil can take animal shape, or make a person twist around like a snake, or stick out the tongue like a snake, or hiss, or change the appearance of the eyes or face. Sometimes it can cause blindness or dumbness or other sicknesses.

Often, people around the person possessed with a devil can feel an evil presence around that person, or around their home.

A devil does not always manifest through the person's voice. Sometimes it keeps quiet inside the person, and attempts to control those around the person by deceiving them into unbelief and sin. Normally, when it manifests, the horrible presence can be felt by others and the devil tries to control others by fear, or if this does not work, it lies. It is a liar by nature, so that you could almost believe the lie. If you have met a person who lies like this, then that person is an open gateway for a devil to enter into others who yoke with that person. It is a filthy creature often described as a serpent. Sometimes it growls a horribly evil noise.

A devil will not normally reveal itself by speaking through the voice unless the person with the devil agrees to be delivered. Devils come out more easily if the person with the devil is sincere. The person has to truly decide to not yoke with unbelievers as a starting point. The person must decide to be separated from the world. Otherwise the devil will just come straight back in again, and as the scripture says "and taketh with himself seven other spirits more wicked than himself, and they enter in and dwell there: and the last state of that man is worse than the first."

People who have been involved with false churches and practices can be difficult to deliver, unless their false beliefs are straightened out and repented of. Normally they have to cut ties with their false church forever. This is the sacrifice they have to make to be free. Sometimes devils live inside long-time Christians and churches you wouldn't even expect. Devils can even join in singing songs in church. In the synagogues in bible times there were people which had spirits of unclean devils.

Devils always manifest when we speak the King James Bible out loud to expose the devil. Devils can't stand this. God saves us by Jesus Christ by sending us the King James Bible, which is a promise from God and cannot be broken. Devils hate this word. Before it can be exposed, a devil will try to

distract us from the facts in the King James Bible about deliverance, because a devil is the ultimate enemy of our souls. A devil will talk about anything else except deliverance. A devil can talk about visions and can seem very spiritual. This is an unclean spirit of divination.

But once exposed, it will cry out, and if we keep tormenting it in the name of Jesus, the devil will be forced to leave. The King James Bible burns a devil and it becomes very sore.

Sometimes the devil comes out of the mouth when it leaves. The person can cough, sneeze or even vomit out the form of the devil, either a snake or anything else. The devil is an unclean spirit and must come out some way. Sometimes the unclean spirit cries out when it comes out. Sometimes, the person feels torn in the back or chest or anywhere else when it comes out. Other times the person collapses, and then wakes up after the unclean spirit has left.

CASTING OUT DEVILS

There are over 100 references below which prove that casting out devils is a central activity of believers. No hospital or medical treatment can do it. Compare this with other believer activities: singing songs mentioned 7 times, communion mentioned about 15 times, water baptism mentioned about 40 times in the New Testament. Every single service and meeting should have deliverances occurring during the meeting.

A person with a devil is under a curse because that person did things to invite the devil inside. That person may try to break the curse by saying a few words, but this does not break the curse. Particularly when the curse is the result of direct disobedience by the person or if that person is living in disobedience. When the person did those things, the devil comes inside the person's heart and makes his home there. Once the devil has been given an invitation to come inside, he will not leave until he is cast out. This is why we say a person is possessed. The devil swears that he will never leave. Therefore when he goes out it is by force. He is thrown out. He will not go if you ask him! You have to command him with authority.

Before you can cast out a devil you have to get that devil mad in pain by repeating the King James Bible out loud in the ear of the person seeking deliverance. I give you many examples of Scriptures to use below. Especially repeat the underlined portions, three or four times, and the portions in **bold** most of all, unsparingly addressing them to the devil, and then using them to gain command over the devil.

The person must agree to be delivered from sin. As the devil manifests and talks, keep answering the devil with the King James Bible to expose and torment the devil, and command him until he can no longer speak, but must howl, and then force him to depart from the person you are holding, at your command. Unbelievers must beware at this point, in case the devil leaving the person enters into them. This would be a good point for unbelievers to pray that God helps them to overcome their unbelief.

You may place oil (olive oil or any other type of oil) on the palm of your hand and grasp the person's wrist firmly when you call out the final deliverance. This is symbolic of the Blood of Jesus Christ.

All that is required is perseverance. The devil was defeated 2000 years ago at Calvary. We have to consign each devil to the day of Judgment and perdition, to never enter into anyone again. This could take minutes or hours, but it will be done in the end.

THE EXERCISES

AUDIO: Practise as you [listen to Exercise 1](#) and [listen to Exercise 2](#) and [listen to Exercise 3](#) - to have effect, you must SPEAK IT OUT LOUD as you hear it repeated. You may also feel an unction. Lift up your hands and speak in an unknown tongue in short phrases. **You must do this exercise repeating out loud especially the moment you are faced with a worldly temptation or lust, and this will render the power of the temptation powerless.** There are devils of nicotine, foul appetite, lust in advertisements, gambling, money and property and ambition, which all have to be slain this way. **Addictions may require a separate deliverance session, because the devil is now inside and will not come out, and has to be cast out.**

You will have to repent of your sins for your deliverance to be successful. Even just listing these sins will cause you to be tempted. Go immediately into the exercise after you read through the list. A person who sins **will not go to heaven** unless that person repents and then remains clean. This is why we need to overcome temptation:

- Fornication - sex outside marriage
- Adultery
- Telling lies
- Petty theft, dishonesty
- Drinking
- Swearing
- Gambling

- Envy
- Luck charms, horoscopes, getting your fortune told
- Lust
- Pride
- Vanity

Speak the Scriptures below out loud, repeating the underlined and bold portions two or three times:

Matthew 8:16 When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and **he cast out the spirits with his word**, and healed all that were sick:

Matthew 8:31 So **the devils besought him**, saying, **If thou cast us out**, suffer us to go away into the herd of swine.

Matthew 9:33 And when **the devil was cast out**, the dumb spake: and the multitudes marvelled, saying, It was never so seen in Israel.

Matthew 10:8 Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, **cast out devils: freely ye have received**, freely give.

Matthew 12:28 But if **I cast out devils by the Spirit of God**, then the kingdom of God is come unto you.

Mark 1:34 And he healed many that were sick of divers diseases, and **cast out many devils**; and **suffered not the devils to speak**, because **they knew him**.

Mark 1:39 And he preached in their synagogues throughout all Galilee, and **cast out devils**.

Mark 3:15 And **to have power** to heal sicknesses, and **to cast out devils**:

Mark 6:13 And they **cast out many devils**, and **anointed with oil** many that were sick, and healed them.

Mark 7:26 The woman was a Greek, a Syrophenician by nation; and she besought him that he would **cast forth the devil out of her daughter**.

Mark 9:38 And John answered him, saying, Master, **we saw one casting out devils in thy name**, and he followeth not us: and we forbad him, because he followeth not us.

Mark 16:9 Now when Jesus was risen early the first day of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, **out of whom he had cast seven devils**.

Mark 16:17 And these signs shall follow them that believe; **In my name shall they cast out devils**; they shall speak with new tongues;

Luke 11:14 And **he was casting out a devil, and it was dumb**. And it came to pass, when **the devil was gone out, the dumb spake**; and the people wondered.

Luke 13:32 And he said unto them, Go ye, and tell that fox, **Behold, I cast out devils**, and I do cures to day and to morrow, and the third day I shall be perfected.

Revelation 12:9 And the **great dragon was cast out**, that old serpent, called **the Devil, and Satan**, which **deceiveth the whole world**: he was **cast out into the earth**, and **his angels were cast out with him**.

Revelation 20:10 And **the devil that deceived them** was **cast into the lake of fire and brimstone**, where the beast and the false prophet are, and **shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever**.

SATAN

Matthew 4:10 Then saith Jesus unto him, **Get thee hence, Satan**: for it is written, Thou shalt worship the Lord thy God, and him only shalt thou serve.

Matthew 16:23 But he turned, and said unto Peter, **Get thee behind me, Satan: thou art an offence unto me**: for **thou savourest not the things that be of God**, but those that be of men.

Mark 4:15 And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, **Satan cometh immediately, and taketh away the word that was sown in their hearts**.

Mark 8:33 But when he had turned about and looked on his disciples, he rebuked Peter, saying, **Get thee behind me, Satan**: for **thou savourest not the things that be of God**, but the things that be of men.

Luke 10:18 And he said unto them, **I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven**.

Luke 13:16 And ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, **whom Satan hath bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed from this bond** on the sabbath day?

UNCLEAN SPIRITS

Matthew 8:29 And, behold, they cried out, saying, What have we to do with thee, **Jesus, thou Son of God?** art thou come hither **to torment us before the time?**

Matthew 10:1 And when he had called unto him his twelve disciples, he gave them power against unclean spirits, **to cast them out**, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

Matthew 12:43 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he **walketh through dry places, seeking rest, and findeth none.**

Mark 1:23 And there was in their synagogue **a man with an unclean spirit**; and he cried out,

Mark 1:26 And **when the unclean spirit had torn him**, and **cried with a loud voice**, he came out of him.

Mark 1:27 And they were all amazed, insomuch that they questioned among themselves, saying, What thing is this? what new doctrine is this? for **with authority commandeth he even the unclean spirits**, and **they do obey him.**

Mark 3:11 And unclean spirits, when they saw him, **fell down before him**, and cried, **saying, Thou art the Son of God.**

Mark 5:2 And when he was come out of the ship, immediately there met him out of the tombs a man **with an unclean spirit**,

Mark 5:7 And cried with a loud voice, and said, What have I to do with thee, **Jesus, thou Son of the most high God?** I adjure thee by God, that **thou torment me not.**

Mark 5:8 For he said unto him, **Come out of the man, thou unclean spirit.**

Mark 5:9 And he asked him, **What is thy name?** And he answered, saying, **My name is Legion:** for we are many.

Mark 5:13 And forthwith **Jesus gave them leave.** And **the unclean spirits went out**, and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the sea, (they were about two thousand;) **and were choked in the sea.**

Mark 6:7 And he called unto him the twelve, and began to send them forth by two and two; and **gave them power over unclean spirits;**

Mark 7:25 For a certain woman, whose young daughter had an unclean spirit, heard of him, and came and fell at his feet:

Mark 9:25 When Jesus saw that the people came running together, **he rebuked the foul spirit, saying unto him, Thou dumb and deaf spirit, I charge thee, come out of him, and enter no more into him.**

Luke 4:36 And they were all amazed, and spake among themselves, saying, What a word is this! for **with authority and power he commandeth the unclean spirits, and they come out.**

Luke 6:18 And **they that were vexed with unclean spirits:** and **they were healed.**

Luke 7:21 And in that same hour he cured many of their infirmities and plagues, and of evil spirits; and unto many that were blind he gave sight.

Luke 8:28 When he saw Jesus, **he cried out, and fell down before him,** and with a loud voice said, **What have I to do with thee, Jesus, thou Son of God most high?** I beseech thee, torment me not.

Luke 11:24 When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through dry places, seeking rest; and finding none, he saith, I will return unto my house whence I came out.

Acts 5:16 There came also a multitude out of the cities round about unto Jerusalem, bringing sick folks, **and them which were vexed with unclean spirits:** and they were healed every one.

Acts 8:7 For **unclean spirits, crying with loud voice,** came out of many that were possessed with them: and many taken with palsies, and that were lame, were healed.

Acts 16:16 And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:

Acts 19:12 So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

Revelation 16:13 And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet.

THE BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST

Ephesians 2:13 But now in Christ Jesus ye who sometimes were far off are made nigh by the blood of Christ.

Hebrews 9:14 How much more shall the blood of Christ, who through the eternal Spirit offered himself without spot to God, purge your conscience from dead works to serve the living God?

Hebrews 10:19 Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus,

Hebrews 12:24 And to Jesus the mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling, that speaketh better things than that of Abel.

Hebrews 13:20 Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant,

DEVIL

Matthew 4:24 And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto him all sick people that were taken with divers diseases and torments, and **those which were possessed with devils,** and those which were lunatic, and those that had the palsy; **and he healed them.**

Matthew 8:28 And when he was come to the other side into the country of the Gergesenes, there met him **two possessed with devils,** coming out of the tombs, exceeding fierce, so that no man might pass by that way.

Matthew 8:33 And they that kept them fled, and went their ways into the city, and told every thing, and **what was befallen to the possessed of the devils.**

Matthew 9:32 As they went out, behold, they **brought to him a dumb man possessed with a devil.**

Matthew 12:22 Then was **brought unto him one possessed with a devil,** blind, and dumb: and **he healed him,** insomuch that the blind and dumb both spake and saw.

Matthew 13:25 But while men slept, his enemy came and **sowed tares among the wheat,** and went his way.

Matthew 13:28 He said unto them, **An enemy hath done this.** The servants said unto him, Wilt thou then that we go and gather them up?

Matthew 13:39 **The enemy that sowed them is the devil**; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels.

Matthew 15:22 And, behold, a woman of Canaan came out of the same coasts, and cried unto him, saying, Have mercy on me, O Lord, thou son of David; **my daughter is grievously vexed with a devil**.

Matthew 17:18 And **Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him**: and **the child was cured from that very hour**.

Matthew 25:41 Then shall he say also unto them on the left hand, **Depart from me, ye cursed, into everlasting fire, prepared for the devil and his angels**:

Mark 1:32 And at even, when the sun did set, they brought unto him all that were diseased, and **them that were possessed with devils**.

Mark 5:12 And **all the devils besought him**, saying, Send us into the swine, that we may enter into them.

Mark 5:15 And they come to Jesus, and **see him that was possessed with the devil**, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

Mark 5:16 And they that saw it told them **how it befell to him that was possessed with the devil**, and also concerning the swine.

Mark 5:18 And when he was come into the ship, **he that had been possessed with the devil prayed him** that he might be with him.

Mark 7:29 And he said unto her, For this saying go thy way; **the devil is gone out of thy daughter**.

Mark 7:30 And when she was come to her house, **she found the devil gone out**, and her daughter laid upon the bed.

Luke 4:33 And in the synagogue there was a man, **which had a spirit of an unclean devil**, and cried out with a loud voice,

Luke 4:35 And **Jesus rebuked him**, saying, **Hold thy peace, and come out of him**. And **when the devil had thrown him in the midst, he came out of him**, and hurt him not.

Luke 4:41 And **devils also came out of many, crying out,** and saying, **Thou art Christ the Son of God.** And he rebuking them suffered them not to speak: for **they knew that he was Christ.**

Luke 8:2 And **certain women, which had been healed of evil spirits** and infirmities, Mary called Magdalene, **out of whom went seven devils,**

Luke 8:12 Those by the way side are they that hear; **then cometh the devil, and taketh away the word out of their hearts,** lest they should believe and be saved.

Luke 8:27 And when he went forth to land, **there met him out of the city a certain man, which had devils long time,** and ware no clothes, neither abode in any house, but in the tombs.

Luke 8:29 (For **he had commanded the unclean spirit to come out of the man.** For oftentimes it had caught him: and he was kept bound with chains and in fetters; and he brake the bands, and **was driven of the devil into the wilderness.**)

Luke 8:30 And Jesus asked him, saying, **What is thy name? And he said, Legion:** because many devils were entered into him.

Luke 8:33 **Then went the devils out of the man,** and entered into the swine: and the herd ran violently down a steep place into the lake, **and were choked.**

Luke 8:35 Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, **and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed,** sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

Luke 8:36 They also which saw it **told them by what means he that was possessed of the devils was healed.**

Luke 8:38 Now **the man out of whom the devils were departed** besought him that he might be with him: but Jesus sent him away, saying,

Luke 9:1 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and **gave them power and authority over all devils,** and to cure diseases.

Luke 9:42 And as he was yet a coming, **the devil threw him down, and tare him . And Jesus rebuked the unclean spirit, and healed the child,** and delivered him again to his father.

NOTHING SHALL HARM YOU

Luke 10:17 And the seventy returned again with joy, saying, Lord, even the devils are subject unto us through thy name.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.

John 10:21 Others said, These are not the words of him that hath a devil. Can a devil open the eyes of the blind?

Acts 10:38 How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him.

Acts 13:10 And said, O full of all subtlety and all mischief, thou child of the devil, thou enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?

1 Corinthians 10:20 But I say, that the things which the Gentiles sacrifice, they sacrifice to devils, and not to God: and I would not that ye should have fellowship with devils.

1 Corinthians 10:21 Ye cannot drink the cup of the Lord, and the cup of devils: ye cannot be partakers of the Lord's table, and of the table of devils.

1 Corinthians 15:26 The last enemy that shall be destroyed is death.

1 Corinthians 15:55 O death, where is thy sting? O grave, where is thy victory?

Ephesians 4:27 Neither give place to the devil.

Ephesians 6:11 Put on the whole armour of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

1 Timothy 4:1 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed **to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils;**

2 Timothy 2:26 And that they may **recover themselves out of the snare of the devil,** who are taken captive by him at his will.

Hebrews 2:14 Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might **destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil;**

James 4:7 Submit yourselves therefore to God. **Resist the devil, and he will flee from you.**

1 Peter 5:8 Be sober, be vigilant; because **your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, walketh about,** seeking whom he may devour:

1 John 3:8 **He that committeth sin is of the devil; for the devil sinneth from the beginning.** For this purpose the Son of God was manifested, that he might **destroy the works of the devil.**

1 John 3:10 In this the children of God are manifest, and the children of the devil: **whosoever doeth not righteousness is not of God,** neither he that loveth not his brother.

Jude 1:9 Yet Michael the archangel, when contending with the devil he disputed about the body of Moses, durst not bring against him a railing accusation, but said, **The Lord rebuke thee.**

Revelation 9:20 And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues **yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils,** and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk:

Revelation 12:12 Therefore rejoice, ye heavens, and ye that dwell in them. Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and of the sea! for the devil is come down unto you, having great wrath, because **he knoweth that he hath but a short time.**

Revelation 16:14 For **they are the spirits of devils,** working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty.

Revelation 18:2 And he cried mightily with a strong voice, saying, **Babylon the great is fallen, is fallen, and is become the habitation of devils, and the hold of every foul spirit, and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird.**

FIRE

Matthew 3:10 And now also **the ax is laid unto the root of the trees:** therefore every tree which bringeth not forth good fruit is hewn down, and cast into the fire.

Matthew 3:11 I indeed baptize you with water unto repentance: but he that cometh after me is mightier than I, whose shoes I am not worthy to bear: **he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost, and with fire:**

Matthew 3:12 Whose fan is in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and gather his wheat into the garner; but he will burn up the chaff with unquenchable fire.

Matthew 7:19 Every tree that bringeth not forth good fruit is **hewn down, and cast into the fire.**

Matthew 13:42 And shall cast them into a furnace of fire: there shall be **wailing and gnashing of teeth.**

Matthew 17:15 Lord, have mercy on my son: for he is a lunatic, and sore vexed: for oftentimes he falleth into the fire, and oft into the water.

Mark 9:22 And oftentimes it hath cast him into the fire, and into the waters, to destroy him: but if thou canst do any thing, have compassion on us, and help us.

Mark 9:44 Where **their worm dieth not, and the fire is not quenched.**

Luke 3:9 And now also **the ax is laid unto the root of the trees:** every tree therefore which bringeth not forth good fruit is **hewn down, and cast into the fire.**

Luke 3:16 John answered, saying unto them all, I indeed baptize you with water; but one mightier than I cometh, the latchet of whose shoes I am not worthy to unloose: he shall baptize you with the Holy Ghost and with fire:

Luke 3:17 Whose fan is in his hand, and he will thoroughly purge his floor, and will gather the wheat into his garner; but the chaff he will burn with **fire unquenchable**.

Luke 9:39 And, lo, **a spirit taketh him**, and he suddenly crieth out; and it teareth him that he foameth again, and bruising him hardly departeth from him.

Luke 17:29 But the same day that Lot went out of Sodom **it rained fire and brimstone from heaven**, and **destroyed them all**.

John 15:6 If a man abide not in me, **he is cast forth as a branch, and is withered**; and men gather them, and **cast them into the fire, and they are burned**.

Acts 2:3 And there appeared unto them **cloven tongues like as of fire**, and it sat upon each of them.

Acts 2:19 And I will show wonders in heaven above, and signs in the earth beneath; **blood, and fire, and vapour of smoke**:

1 Corinthians 3:13 Every man's work shall be made manifest: for **the day shall declare it**, because **it shall be revealed by fire**; and the fire shall try every man's work of what sort it is.

2 Thessalonians 1:8 **In flaming fire taking vengeance on them that know not God**, and **that obey not the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ**:

Hebrews 11:34 **Quenched the violence of fire**, escaped the edge of the sword, out of weakness were made strong, waxed valiant in fight, **turned to flight the armies of the aliens**.

Hebrews 12:29 For **our God is a consuming fire**.

James 3:6 And the tongue is a fire, **a world of iniquity**: so is the tongue among our members, that it defileth the whole body, and setteth on fire the course of nature; and it **is set on fire of hell**.

2 Peter 3:7 But the heavens and the earth, which are now, by the same word are kept in store, **reserved unto fire against the day of judgment and perdition of ungodly men**.

2 Peter 3:12 Looking for and hasting unto the coming of the day of God, wherein **the heavens being on fire shall be dissolved**, and **the elements shall melt with fervent heat?**

Jude 1:7 Even as Sodom and Gomorrha, and the cities about them in like manner, giving themselves over to fornication, and going after strange flesh, are set forth for an example, **suffering the vengeance of eternal fire.**

Jude 1:23 And others save with fear, **pulling them out of the fire**; hating even the garment spotted by the flesh.

Revelation 10:1 And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow was upon his head, and his face was as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:

Revelation 11:5 And if any man will hurt them, **fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies**: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.

Revelation 14:10 The same shall **drink of the wine of the wrath of God**, which is poured out without mixture into **the cup of his indignation**; and he shall **be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb**:

Revelation 14:11 And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they **have no rest day nor night**, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name.

Revelation 15:2 And I saw as it were a sea of glass mingled with fire: and **them that had gotten the victory over the beast**, and over his image, and over his mark, and over the number of his name, **stand on the sea of glass, having the harps of God.**

Revelation 16:8 And the fourth angel poured out his vial upon the sun; and **power was given unto him to scorch men with fire.**

Revelation 18:7 How much she hath glorified herself, and lived deliciously, **so much torment and sorrow give her**: for she saith in her heart, I sit a queen, and am no widow, and shall see no sorrow.

Revelation 18:8 Therefore shall her plagues come in one day, death, and mourning, and famine; and she shall **be utterly burned with fire: for strong is the Lord God who judgeth her.**

Revelation 18:10 Standing afar off for **the fear of her torment**, saying, Alas, alas that great city Babylon, that mighty city! for **in one hour is thy judgment come**.

Revelation 18:15 The merchants of these things, which were made rich by her, shall stand afar off **for the fear of her torment, weeping and wailing**,

Revelation 19:12 **His eyes were as a flame of fire**, and on his head were many crowns; and he had a name written, that no man knew, but he himself.

Revelation 19:20 And **the beast was taken**, and with him the false prophet that wrought miracles before him, with which **he deceived them that had received the mark of the beast**, and them that worshipped his image. **These both were cast alive into a lake of fire burning with brimstone.**

Revelation 20:9 And they went up on the breadth of the earth, and compassed the camp of the saints about, and the beloved city: and **fire came down from God out of heaven, and devoured them.**

Revelation 20:10 And **the devil that deceived them** was **cast into the lake of fire and brimstone**, where the beast and the false prophet are, and **shall be tormented day and night for ever and ever.**

Revelation 20:14 And **death and hell were cast into the lake of fire**. This is **the second death**.

Revelation 20:15 And **whosoever was not found written in the book of life was cast into the lake of fire.**

Revelation 21:8 But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and **all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone**: which is **the second death**.

DELIVERANCE

Isaiah 14:16 They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, and consider thee, saying, **Is this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms;**

Isaiah 14:17 That **made the world as a wilderness**, and **destroyed the cities** thereof; that **opened not the house of his prisoners?**

Isaiah 14:21 **Prepare slaughter for his children** for the iniquity of their fathers; that they **do not rise, nor possess the land, nor fill the face of the world with cities.**

Isaiah 14:24 **The LORD of hosts hath sworn**, saying, Surely as I have thought, **so shall it come to pass**; and as I have purposed, **so shall it stand**:

Isaiah 27:1 In that day the LORD with **his sore and great and strong sword** shall **punish leviathan the piercing serpent**, even **leviathan that crooked serpent**; and he shall **slay the dragon that is in the sea.**

Ezekiel 28:12 Son of man, take up a lamentation upon the king of Tyrus, and say unto him, Thus saith the Lord GOD; **Thou sealest up the sum, full of wisdom, and perfect in beauty.**

Ezekiel 28:13 **Thou hast been in Eden the garden of God**; every precious stone was thy covering, the sardius, topaz, and the diamond, the beryl, the onyx, and the jasper, the sapphire, the emerald, and the carbuncle, and gold: the workmanship of thy tabrets and of thy pipes was prepared in thee **in the day that thou wast created.**

Ezekiel 28:14 Thou art the **anointed cherub** that covereth; and I have set thee so: thou wast **upon the holy mountain of God**; thou hast walked up and down **in the midst of the stones of fire.**

Ezekiel 28:15 Thou wast perfect in thy ways from the day that thou wast created, **till iniquity was found in thee.**

Ezekiel 28:16 By the multitude of thy merchandise they have filled the midst of thee with violence, and **thou hast sinned**: therefore **I will cast thee as profane out of the mountain of God**: and **I will destroy thee, O covering cherub**, from the midst of the stones of fire.

Ezekiel 28:17 **Thine heart was lifted up** because of thy beauty, thou hast corrupted thy wisdom by reason of thy brightness: **I will cast thee to the ground, I will lay thee before kings, that they may behold thee.**

Ezekiel 28:18 **Thou hast defiled thy sanctuaries** by **the multitude of thine iniquities**, by the iniquity of thy traffic; therefore will I bring forth a fire from the midst of thee, it shall devour thee, and **I will bring thee to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold thee.**

Ezekiel 28:19 All they that know thee among **the people shall be astonished at thee**: thou shalt **be a terror**, and **never shalt thou be any more**.
