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International Repentance, Forgiveness, & Reconciliation (I.R.F.R.) Week: The Forgiveness Processes for Children, Teens, & Adults

"Holding onto Resentment or Anger from Childhood Could Lead to Bullies, Suicides, and/or Unhappy Adults"

June 21-27, 2015- Princeton, NJ- Beginning on the 21st of each month for a week, Prophetess Letitia Peters host International Repentance, Forgiveness, and Reconciliation (I.R.F.R.) Week for children, teens, and even adults. During the week, each day people are requested to repent, forgive, or reconcile with a different segment of the population and even reconcile their relationship with God for those who are mad with him. Various forgiveness processes, biblical scriptures about forgiveness and using Jesus/Yeshua as a role model are discussed. Prophetess Peters started out discussing about forgiveness and the forgiveness process for children and teens due to the teasing, bullying, and suicides. There had to be an underlying reason why so many young people are committing suicide or killing their other people. Who are teaching children and teens about forgiveness or the forgiveness process? The parents/guardians? The schools? The church? In the meantime, what she was doing for others even helped her with forgiving those who were harming, persecuting, or was even an adversary to her soul as a "secret" lifetime, generational involuntary or unwitting human subject.

Since then, she has incorporated the adults because they are still holding onto resentment or anger from their past or childhood, which they have not addressed or fully let go by forgiving the person or people. As a result, they are committing suicides. They are bullies. They are unhappy, angry, or resentful adults. How could they teach their children or teens about how to forgive or the forgiveness process when they do not know how themselves. Who are teaching the adults about forgiveness or the forgiveness process? The church?

The families of the Charleston, SC shooting should be commended because they did the right thing by forgiving the shooter. As a result, believers/saints are requested to use the Word of God to demonstrate His Power through prayer and fasting to raise them from the dead. The enemy is using this 21 year old man as an example. What was meant for evil God will turn it around for good? What would be more important for the families seeing their loved ones raised from the dead or having this young man spend the rest of his life in prison for 9 murder charges? Some angry adults made some disturbing comments that the families should not have forgave the shooter. Obviously, I.R.F.R. Week is needed. Someone wants to start a race war, as well as, a war against believers/saints.

Many people do not realize that they are blocking their own blessings in their lives, because they failed to forgive those who have hurt them, persecute them or are adversaries to their soul. Forgiveness is a process and it is about more than just saying "I am sorry". Forgiveness brings freedom. In Dr. Ed Murphy's book, "The Handbook of Spiritual Warfare" states, "Those who hurt you have their own guilt, but it is guilt before God, not before you. You are not responsible for their actions. You are only responsible for your reactions to their actions. People are always held responsible for their sins, even sins provoked by the unjust actions of others. Some people have become so accustomed to their self-pity, anger, feelings of inferiority, rejection; they really don't want to change. For many, it has become an excuse for other sins, which they do not want to abandon. When you forgive and can really pray for the salvation and transformation of those who have hurt you most, you are on the way to healing. God moves in answer to the prayers of His saints."

What is forgiveness?

Someone said, "Forgiveness is giving up the right to hate those who have wrong you." Forgiveness is a powerful choice you can make when it's right for you that can lead to greater well-being and better relationships. (Sources *The How of Happiness*, by Sonja Lyubomirsky) Forgiveness is an emotional process of clearing past hurts so you can be free to live your happiest life as an adult or child. Researchers who study forgiveness and its effects on our well-being and happiness are very specific about how they define forgiveness. Psychologist Sonja Lyubomirsky calls forgiveness "a shift in thinking" toward someone who has wronged you, "such that your desire to harm that person has decreased and your desire to do him good (or to benefit your relationship) has increased." Forgiveness, at a minimum, is a decision to let go of the desire for revenge and ill-will toward the person who wronged you. It may also include feelings of goodwill toward

the other person. Forgiveness is also a natural resolution of the grief process, which is the necessary acknowledgment of pain and loss.

From a biblical perspective, we are commanded to forgive by Jesus Christ/Yeshua as stated in Matthew 6:14-15 & Mark 11:25-26. Matthew 6:14-15 states, "For if you forgive men for their transgressions, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions" and Mark11:25-26 states, "And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses." This is one possible reason why believers/saints are not receiving their blessings because they are being disobedient to the

Word of God.

For example, a fifteen year old girl, the victim of years of incest on the part of her father, had come for counseling. As the Christian counselor brought up the subject of her need to forgive her father for the evil he had done to her, she reacted with anger against his suggestion saying, "Why should I forgive my father for ruining the first fifteen years of my life?" The counselor wisely immediately replied, "If you don't, you will be allowing him to ruin the next fifteen years of your life." What words of wisdom? The root of bitterness defiles many, Paul says. It especially defiles the one in whom the root is nourished (Heb. 12:15)."

Using the Holy Bible to Teach about Forgiveness

The Holy Bible should be the guide when teaching about forgiveness. Here are several Bible Verses to use to teach about forgiveness: Using Jesus/Yeshua as a Role Model for Forgiveness when He was Crucified on the Cross

And when they came to the place called The Skull, there they crucified Him and the criminals, one on the right and the other on the left. But Jesus was saying, "Father, forgive them; for they do not know what they are doing." And they cast lots, dividing up His garments among themselves (Luke 23:33-34). In essence, "we are all the children of God by faith in Christ Jesus (Galatians 4:1)." Jesus Christ/Yeshua died for ALL of mankind.

- 1. Why should you repent? Sin is still serious. You should confess & repent because sin still separates you from enjoying the full fellowship with our Heavenly Father and his son, Yeshua (1 John 1). "If we confess our sins, He is faithful and righteous to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness" (1 John 1:9). "We have fellowship one with another & the blood of Jesus Christ/Yeshua his Son cleanseth us from all sin" (1 John 1:7).
- 2. What are the sins that you should confess and repent that defile man; And he said, That which cometh out of the man, that defileth the man. For from within, out of the heart of men, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lasciviousness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness: All these evil things come from within, and defile the

man. (Mark 7:20-23)? We tend to think that doing wrong is sin. Sin is also not doing right. Think of the sins that you committed intentionally, unintentionally, or your reaction to a wrongful act or injustice that was done to you, which may be causing you pain, a hardened heart, sickness or disease. Think of your generational iniquities as well.

Here are the 6 sin-related scriptures:

Therefore, to him who knows to do good and does not do it, to him it is sin (James 4:17).

Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived; neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God (1 Corinthians 6:9-10).

But the cowardly, unbelieving, abominable, murderers, sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars shall have their part in the lake which burns with fire and brimstone, which is the second death (**Revelation 21:8**).

Jesus said, "of sin, because they believe not on me" (John 16:9)).

For this ye know, that no whoremonger, no unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, hath any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ & of God (**Ephesians 5:5**).

Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are these; adultery, fornication, uncleanness, lasciviousness, idolatry, witchcraft, hatred, variance, emulations, wrath, strife, seditions, heresies, envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, & such like; of the which I tell you before, as I have also told you in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God (Galatians 5:19-22).

- 3. Why should you forgive? Jesus Christ/Yeshua said if you don't forgive others of their trespasses/transgressions, then your heavenly Father will NOT forgive you, but if you do forgive others of their trespasses/transgressions, then your heavenly Father will forgive you as stated in Matthew 6:14-15 and Mark 11:25-26. "For if you forgive men for their transgressions, your heavenly Father will also forgive you. But if you do not forgive men, then your Father will not forgive your transgressions" (Matthew 6:14-15). "And when ye stand praying, forgive, if ye have ought against any: that your Father also which is in heaven may forgive you your trespasses. But if ye do not forgive, neither will your Father which is in heaven forgive your trespasses." (Mark 11:25-26).
- 4. **How can you forgive others?** 2 ways that you can forgive others: (1) by praying & releasing that person to God or (2) by confronting the offender/perpetuator and ask for forgiveness as stated in Luke 17:3, "if he repents. "So watch yourselves. "If your brother sins, rebuke him, and if he repents, forgive him."

5. How many times should you forgive?

Then Peter came and said to Him, "Lord, how often shall my brother sin against me and I forgive him? Up to seven times?" Jesus said to him, "I do not say to you, up to seven times, but up to seventy times seven" (Matthew 18:21-22).

6. How to Treat Your Enemies

"But if your enemy is hungry, feed him, and if he is thirsty, give him a drink; for in so doing you will heap burning coals upon his head" (**Romans 12:20**).

7. Love, Bless, and Pray for Your Enemies

"But I say to you, love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them, which despitefully use you, and persecute you" (Matthew 5:44).

8. Other Scriptures

"Be angry and do not sin: do not let the sun go down on your wrath, nor give place to the devil" (Ephesians 4:26-27).

"I tell you, on the day of judgment people will give account for every careless word they speak, for by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned." (Matthew 12:36-37) "Either make the tree good and its fruit good, or make the tree bad and its fruit bad, for the tree is known by its fruit. You brood of vipers! How can you speak good, when you are evil? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. The good person out of his good treasure brings forth good, and the evil person out of his evil treasure brings forth evil." (Matthew 12:33-35)

"Researchers are very clear about what forgiveness is not:

Forgiveness is not the same as reconciliation. Forgiveness is one person' sinner response to another's perceived injustice. Reconciliation is two people coming together in mutual respect. Reconciliation requires both parties working together. Forgiveness is something that is entirely up to you. Although reconciliation may follow forgiveness, it is possible to forgive without re-establishing or continuing the relationship. The person you forgive may be deceased or no longer part of your life. You may also choose not to reconcile, perhaps because you have no reason to believe that a relationship with the other person is healthy for you.

Forgiveness is not forgetting. "Forgive and forget" seem to go together. However, the process of forgiving involves acknowledging to yourself the wrong that was done to you, reflecting on it, and deciding how you want to think about it. Focusing on forgetting a wrong might lead to denying or suppressing feelings about it, which is not the same as forgiveness. Forgiveness has taken place when you can remember the wrong that was done without feeling resentment or a desire to pursue revenge. Sometimes, after we get to this point, we may forget about some of the wrong people have done to us. But we don't have to forget in order to forgive.

Forgiveness is not condoning or excusing. Forgiveness does not minimize, justify, or excuse the wrong that was done. Forgiveness also does not mean denying the harm and the feelings that the injustice produced. And forgiveness does not mean putting yourself in a position to be harmed again. You can forgive someone and still take healthy steps to protect yourself, including choosing not to reconcile.

Forgiveness is not justice. It is certainly easier to forgive someone who sincerely apologizes and makes amends. However, justice—which may include acknowledgment of the wrong, apologies, punishment, restitution, or compensation—is separate from forgiveness. You may pursue your rights for justice with or without forgiving someone. And if justice is denied, you can still choose whether or not to forgive."

Forgive yourself or self-forgiveness – Are you harboring unforgiveness, bitterness, grudges, resentment, offenses, deep-seated anger, bitterness, hatred, guilt, self-pity, evil thoughts, fear and/ or you know the truth about something & you have not told it or done anything about it? Racism is a byproduct of hatred, which is a sin. In order to restore joy, health, love, self-love, freedom & peace back into your life you should forgive yourself and others? We tend to think that doing wrong is sin. Sin is also not doing right. Think of the sins that you committed intentionally, unintentionally, or your reaction to wrongful acts or injustices that was done to you, which may be causing you pain, a hardened heart, or disease. Are you harboring deep-seated anger, bitterness, hatred, unforgiveness, guilt, self-pity, evil thoughts, fear and/ or you know the truth about something & you have not told it or done anything about it? It is a proven fact that the root cause of having these toxic emotions could be the cause of your sickness or disease & once you address these toxic emotions, then your sickness or disease will disappear.

Forgive Others From Your Past & Present- family members, friends, ex-spouses, classmates, co-workers, enemies and/or forgive people of different ethnic & racial backgrounds. People will learn about the importance of forgiving others.

Scriptures About People:

Let all the people of my nation turn to the Lord & worship Him (Psalm 22:27)

Let all the idolaters in my nation be confounded, & let all the gods worship the Lord (Psalm 97:7)

Let the poor & needy people of my nation be delivered (Psalm 72:12-13).

Let your glory be declared among my people, & Your wonders in my nation (Psalm 96:3).

Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name. Bless the LORD, O my soul, and do not forget all his benefits: Who forgives all your iniquities; who heals all thy diseases; Who redeems your life from destruction; who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies; Who satisfies your mouth with good things; so that your youth is renewed like the eagle's (Psalm 103:1-5).

Reconcile with God & Forgive the Church, Jewish & Gentiles Church/Synagogue Leaders, & Church Members/Staff- Apostasy is running rampant in the nations. The church leaders are the shepherds. As the shepherds, they have a heavy responsibility to lead people to God and lead them out of sin. The Church Did Not Teach the Word of God to Save A Little Boy's Mother From Dying
Prophetess Letitia Peters remembers the story of an evangelist who told the story about his conversation with

WHERE Is the Evidence?

They Preached, Cast Out Devils, Raise the Dead, Power Over ALL devils, Anointed with Oil & Heal Sickness

Matthew 8:15-17 And he touched her hand, and the fever left her: and she arose, and ministered unto them. When the even was come, they brought unto him many that were possessed with devils: and he cast out the spirits with his word, and healed all that were sick: That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Esaias the prophet, saying, Himself took our infirmities, and bare our sicknesses.

Matthew 10:7-8 And as ye go, preach, saying, The kingdom of heaven is at hand. Heal the sick, cleanse the lepers, raise the dead, cast out devils: freely ye have received, freely give.

Mark 6:12-13 And they went out, and preached that men should repent. And they cast out many devils, and anointed with oil many that were sick, and healed them.

Mark 3:14-15 And he ordained twelve, that they should be with him, and that he might send them forth to preach, And to have power to heal sicknesses, and to cast out devils:

Luke 9:1-3 Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases. And he sent them to preach the kingdom of God, and to heal the sick. And he said unto them, Take nothing for your journey, neither staves, nor scrip, neither bread, neither money; neither have two coats apiece.

Luke 10:19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you.

Scriptures To Be Saved: "That if thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thine heart that God hath raised him from the dead, thou shalt be saved. For with the heart man believeth unto righteousness; and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation. For the scripture saith, Whosoever believeth on him shall not be ashamed." (Romans 10:9-11)

One of the 12 "Secret" Keys to Develop a Personal Relationship with God & to become an Anointed & Powerful Believer/Saint: HAVE A "PRIVATE CONVERSATION WITH GOD/YAHWEH THROUGH JESUS/YESHUA BY GOING INTO THE "CLOSET". He comes to give life more abundantly & Satan comes to steal, kill, or destroy (John 10:10). This action of going into the "closet" to talk to God can be done as frequent as you would like.

2 Timothy 1:7 For God hath not given us the spirit of fear; but of power, and of love, and of a sound mind.

Romans 10:17 So then faith cometh by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

1 Corinthians 12:13 For by one Spirit are we all baptized into one body, whether *we be* Jews or Gentiles, whether *we be* bond or free; and have been all made to drink into one Spirit.

1 John 4:3 And every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that *spirit of* antichrist, whereof ye have heard that it should come; and even now already is it in the world.

Philippians 2:9-11 Wherefore God also hath highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name: That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth; And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

And whosoever will not receive you, when ye go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet for a testimony against them. And they departed, and went through the towns, preaching the gospel, and healing every where.

1 Timothy 4:1-3 Now the Spirit speaketh expressly, that in the latter times some shall depart from the faith, giving heed to seducing spirits, and doctrines of devils; Speaking lies in hypocrisy; having their conscience seared with a hot iron; Forbidding to marry, and commanding to abstain from meats, which God hath created to be received with thanksgiving of them which believe and know the truth.

Matthew 21:12-13 And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves, And said unto them, It is written, My house shall be called the house of prayer; but ye have made it a den of thieves.

Yeshua is mentioned in the Tanakh/Old Testament:

Forgiveness Process for Children, Teens, & Adults

According to Maureen Healy, child development expert who focus on children's emotional health and parenting. Her organization is called Growing Happy Kids (www.growinghappykids.com). In her article, "Are you really teaching your kids how to forgive?" she states, "Forgiveness doesn't merely occur when a little kid says, "I am sorry" for hitting you in the head with a football. You actually need to consciously go through a process of forgiving so you don't hold any resentment or anger. Think about it this way. Were you ever teased in school? What was his or her name? I remember David Smith* who made fun of me out the bus window in 1986 - it's as clear as day. Fortunately, I don't feel any emotion around this but if I did then some forgiveness work would be needed. The same is true of kids. Terry stole her sister's bathing suit, broke one of the straps and infuriated her sister. Terry said, "I am sorry" and her sister was theoretically was supposed to just forgive. But what again does that mean? It means a whole lot more than a blanket "I am sorry" that supposed to magically sweep clean the situation. I have found that parents that teach their kids how to "really forgive" set them up to succeed and create a foundation of strength as well as self-love.

Here are 5 Simple Steps for Actual Forgiveness:

Acknowledge
 Experience
 Communicate
 Acknowledge What Happened
 Experience Your Feelings
 Say you want to forgive

4. Forgive State you don't want to carry the anger anymore

(or frustration, guilt, resentment)

5. Release Let it go. Give your anger to Great Spirit

(Buddha, Jesus, Source, Nature, Universe).

Each of these steps must be felt from the heart but acted upon sequentially so a child learns how to truly forgive another child (parent, sister, and friend). It will free their emotional body from unresolved grief, pain, sadness and hurt. And it would look like this, Jessie states: Terry, you stole my bathing suit and broke it. My feelings are hurt. This stinks. I want to forgive you. Please don't take my things without asking. I don't want to fight. I love you. Forgiveness is an emotional process of clearing past hurts so you can be free to live your happiest life as an adult or child. Forgiveness isn't exclusively about becoming emotionally free. It is a mindset that when cultivated can help you see yourself as part of a larger community of people that are perfectly imperfect - each of us has needed to forgive someone, and also be forgiven so the practice goes both ways.

One mother, Margaret, told me that she sits with her kids nightly and says "Is there anyone who we are holding outside of our hearts?" so the topic of forgiveness is put on the table and used to clear any daily hurts."

Examples of Three Other Forgiveness Processes:

Dr. Everett Worthington, a psychologist who has researched forgiveness for decades, has developed a five-step process called REACH:

R is for Recall. Recall the events and the hurt as accurately and objectively as you can.

E is for Empathize. Try to understand what happened from the point of view of the person who wronged you.

A is for the Altruistic gift of forgiveness. Recall a time that you hurt someone else and were forgiven. And offer this gift to the person who wronged you.

C is for Committing yourself to forgive publicly. Write a letter of forgiveness (whether you send it or not), write in a journal, tell a trusted friend, or, if you can, tell the person who wronged you.

H is for Holding onto forgiveness. Forgiving is not forgetting. Memories of the wrong and feelings will come up. Remind yourself that you have made a choice to forgive.

Dr. Robert Enright suggests a four-phase process in *Forgiveness is a Choice*:

- Uncover your anger; honestly examine the unjust act and your feelings about it.
- Decide to forgive; be willing to turn your back on the past and look toward the future.
- Work on forgiveness; forgiving is a process that takes recommitment and concrete actions.
- Discovery and release; be open to discovering the meaning of suffering, the need for forgiveness, the fact that you are not alone, and a new purpose in life.

Dr. Sonja Lyubormirsky offers additional exercises in her book The How of Happiness:

• Appreciate being forgiven; reflect on a time when you were forgiven; or seek forgiveness for a wrong you have done

- Imagine forgiveness; imagine what you might say to the person and how you would feel
- Write a letter of forgiveness; not necessarily to send, but to write out what happened and how it affected you, what you wish the person had done, and end with a statement of understanding and forgiveness
- Write the other person's apology letter; not necessarily to send, but imagine the explanation the person would give for her/his behavior and how she/he feels about the harm she/he has done

The Church Did Not Teach the Word of God to Save A Little Boy's Mother From Dying

Prophetess Letitia remembers the story of an evangelist who told the story about his conversation with God after his mother died from cancer when he was a child. Many church/synagogue leaders, evangelists, priests, teachers, apostles, prophets, pastors & bishops are not teaching deliverance even though Jesus/Yeshua and His disciples performed it all the time. It is mentioned in Jesus'/Yeshua's Great Commission, which many only quote the first line, Mark 16:15, "Go ye into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature", but not the rest of it. Jesus/Yeshua continues in Mark 16:16-18, "He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned. And these signs shall follow them that believe; In my name shall they cast out devils; they shall speak with new tongues; They shall take up serpents; and if they drink any deadly thing, it shall not hurt them; they shall lay hands on the sick, and they shall recover." God is a spirit. All manner of sickness and disease are evil spirits, which should be bind, rebuke, and cast out in the name of Jesus/Yeshua.

In Bert M. Farias' article, "Demon-Filled Man Mocks, Slaps 'Powerless' Charismatic Pastor", he states, "The Bible says demons know churches and men. I am a big proponent of the supernatural power of God. I came into it when I was baptized in the Holy Ghost shortly after my conversion. I will never understand men who reason away or dumb down the supernatural workings of God and His sacred gifts. I realize there are sensationalists and religious fanatics who abuse and misuse God's gifts and power, but that doesn't do away with the real. Once you've tasted the genuine move of the Holy Spirit it is difficult to settle for anything else. Several years ago I was ministering in Gambia, West Africa. In one of the meetings as the saints broke out in dancing and joy a demon possessed young man was struck by the power of God on the streets next to the facility. He froze and couldn't move. Finally the men brought him into the meeting and we cast the evil spirit out of him and ministered salvation and the baptism of Holy Ghost to him. As I interviewed this young man afterwards, I became fascinated with his testimony. For 12 years he'd been under the spell of Satan. From a very young age demons unveiled the spirit world to him as degree by degree they possessed him. I asked him many questions and I will not elaborate on the entire interview I had with him, but I want to enforce one main point that was very compelling to me. I asked him if he'd ever sought to be delivered from these demons. He told me that he'd visited many churches, but none could help him. As a matter of fact, instead of being helped the demons in this young man often hurt the amateur exorcists. For example, in the largest charismatic church in the country the demon in this man slapped the pastor and ransacked his office, repeatedly telling him that this church had no power to set him free. "All this church does is talk about money and they don't live holy," the demon said. Can you believe a demon said that? Demons know churches. Demons know men. "Jesus I know, Paul I know, but who are you?" (Acts 19:15). This incident made me wonder: How many of our churches are really a threat to Satan's kingdom? Many do not even believe in the supernatural. Others profess to believe in it, but have no works to show for it. And still there are others who are just talking to themselves. Ministers will often tell you that these things happen as the Spirit wills. However, if your church hasn't had these manifestations in 10 or 20 years, it's not because the Spirit hasn't been willing. The problem is on the receiving end. Some say, "You can't turn these things on and off!" But I have found from experience that the Holy Spirit is always on. The

question should be: Are you on or off? If the move of the Spirit is not passed on to this next generation it will be lost. Let's wake up to this light and walk therein. Get turned on because the Holy Ghost is always on." Church, We Don't Need Motivational Speeches, but the Demonstration of the Power of the Word of God

Five Indicators of an Evil and Wicked Heart

Prophetess Letitia Peters posted this article on Facebook and gave her FBF a challenge to give a copy of this article to their church leaders. One response said, this article should be read by all church leaders.

Leslie Vernick states in *5 Indicators of an Evil and Wicked Heart*, "As Christian counselors, pastors and people helpers we often have a hard time discerning between an evil heart and an ordinary sinner who messes up, who isn't perfect, and full of weakness and sin. I think one of the reasons we don't "see" evil is because we find it so difficult to believe that evil individuals actually exist. We can't imagine someone deceiving us with no conscience, hurting others with no remorse, spinning outrageous fabrications to ruin someone's reputation, or pretending he or she is spiritually committed yet has no fear of God before his or her eyes. The Bible clearly tells us that among God's people there are wolves that wear sheep's clothing (Jeremiah 23:14; Titus 1:10; Revelations 2:2). It's true that every human heart is inclined toward sin (Romans 3:23), and that includes evil (Genesis 8:21; James 1:4). We all miss God' mark of moral perfection. However, most ordinary sinners do not happily indulge evil urges, nor do we feel good about having them. We feel ashamed and guilty, rightly so (Romans 7:19–21). These things are not true of the evil heart. She discuss five indicators that you may be dealing with an evil heart rather than an ordinary sinful heart. If so, it requires a radically different treatment approach. The Bible has some strong words for those whose actions do not match their talk (1 John 3:17,18; Jeremiah 7:8,10; James 1:22, 26). John the Baptist said it best when he admonished the religious leaders, "Prove by the way you live that you have repented of your sins and turned to God" (Luke 3:8). If week after week you hear the talk but there is no change in

the walk, you have every reason to question someone's relationship with God. Part of our maturity as spiritual leaders is that we have been trained to discern between good and evil. Why is that so important? It's important because evil usually pretends to be good, and without discernment we can be easily fooled (Hebrews 5:14). When you confront evil, chances are good that the evil heart will stop counseling with you because the darkness hates the light (John 3:20) and the foolish and evil heart reject correction (Proverbs 9:7,8). But that outcome is far better than allowing the evil heart to believe you are on his or her side, or that "he's not that bad" or "that he's really sorry" or "that he's changing" when, in fact, he is not. Daniel says, "[T]he wicked will continue to be wicked" (Daniel 12:10), which begs the question, do you think an evil person can really change? The Power of Prayer & Fasting

The church leaders have been telling people to pray. People have been praying for years for a revival and they have not receive a breakthrough or answer from God. There is another alternative - prayer & fasting as stated in Matthew 17:14-21. Fasting will loose the bands of wickedness, let the oppressed go free, & break every yoke as stated in Isaiah 58:6. The disciples were having difficulty curing a child of lunatic and sore vexed. Matthew 17:18-21 states, "And Jesus rebuked the devil; and he departed out of him: and the child was cured from that very hour. Then came the disciples to Jesus apart, and said, "Why could not we cast him out?" And Jesus said unto them, "Because of your unbelief: for verily I say unto you, If ye have faith as a grain of mustard seed, ye shall say unto this mountain, Remove hence to yonder place; and it shall remove; and nothing shall be impossible unto you. Howbeit this kind goeth not out but by prayer and fasting."

Blessings of Prayer & Fasting

God calls us to fast. Fasting means to abstain from food or some food. By fasting, one shows discipline, humility before God, & faith. Fasting will break every yoke of bondage (Isaiah 58). Sometimes, fasting is a sign of humbling and mourning (Lev.23:27: Joel 2:12-13: Deut.9:25-29). At other times, fasting can be a praise offering to the Lord and it contains an element of joy and gladness (Psalm 50:14 & 23; Zech.8:19). Sometimes, fasting is a help in intercession other times, fasting is for personal requests, personal growth and victory over sin or just for situations of unusual pressure or oppression. Fasting will loose the bands of wickedness, let the oppressed go free & break every yoke as stated in Isaiah 58:6. You are humbling yourself by prayer and fasting. It is written, "So we fasted and besought our God for this: and he was intreated of us" (Ezra 8:23). Daniel faithfully continued praying and fasting for 21 days while waiting for an answer from God. God's messenger arrived 21 days later stating from the first day his words were heard by God, but the prince of the kingdom of Persia had detained him and Michael, one of the chief princes came to help him (Daniel 9 & 10). Satan may intervene in delaying your response from God, but you must have faith & no doubt. There are various fasts depicted in The Power of Fasting & Prayer by Peet Grobbelaar & Bennie Mostert that can be downloaded at www.ManifestTheTruth.com. In the Power of Fasting & Prayer book, it states, "Time and again we see in the Scriptures where prayer, together with fasting, ended up with miraculous results. A spiritual power accompanies fasting, which is not explicable in a rational way. The faith that rises above stiff-necked opposition, such as the opposition of evil spirits, is only possible for those who walk in close fellowship with God and who separate themselves from the world in prayer and fasting. Fasting often brings about a full maturity in intercession. Fasting, intercession and prayer warfare are linked very closely together. Jesus was victorious over Satan's temptations in Matthew 4 because of prayer and fasting. God gave revival many times in the past as an answer to intense periods of prayer and fasting. Most of the hundreds of revivals over the past 300 years, have been preceded by people who, amongst other things, prayed and fasted. Nations, people groups and cities are spared and saved when people humble themselves before God in prayer and fasting. Fasting plays a very important role when we are involved with spiritual warfare. We read about the Moabites and the Ammonites advancing against Juda with a massive army, in 2 Chronicles 20:1-30. Jehosephat called a day of fasting and prayer for the whole nation, and asked God to intervene. The result was that God did intervene. The Lord brought about a massive and miraculous victory. This was the result of prayer and fasting."
